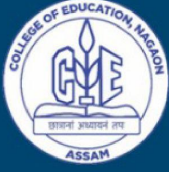
PREFACE

Intake Capacity and Reservation

The intake capacity of the college for admission for B.Ed. as approved by NCTE is 100 and for M.Ed. 50 and B.A. with 120 seats. The reservation for students belonging to ST/SC/OBC/MOBC/EWS/PWD will be in accordance with the prescribed rules of the Govt. of Assam.

Eligibility for Admission

Candidates must have at least 55% marks in B.Ed. for admission in M.Ed. and 50% marks in aggregate in the BA/B.Sc./B.Com. (10+2+3) or MA/M.Sc./M.Com. examination of a recognized university to be eligible for applying to the B.Ed. course. There is the provision for relaxation of marks up to 5% for ST/SC/OBC/MOBC/ candidates as per the existing rules of the Govt. of Assam.

Candidates are admitted on the basis of entrance examination conducted by Gauhati University.

Procedure for Admission

The Admission Forms along with Prospectus can be obtained from the college office at all working hours on payment of Rs. 1000.00 (One Thousand only).

Identity Card

Every student will be issued a non-transferable identity card on the day of Fresher's Social. Along with the necessary information, the identity card contains a passport size Photograph of the student duly endorsed by the Principal. It is necessary on the part of every student to keep the identity card with him/her so that it can be produced as and when necessary.

Library

There is a well-stocked library with well equipped reading room facilities where approximately more than 6000 books are available which include mainly text books and reference books on teacher education. The library also has a number of encyclopedias, educational and research journals. Library cards are issued to each student after depositing library caution money of Rs. 700/- (refundable) as security money for borrowing books from the library. Computer and Internet facilities are available in college library.

Laboratories

Psychological Laboratory, Geography Laboratory, Language Laboratory and well-equipped Educational Technology Laboratory are also available in the college as per the norms framed by NCTE and G.U.

Examination

Apart from the final examinations conducted by G.U., Class Test, unit tests, terminal examination and test examination are held in the college according to the college academic calendar which will be given to the trainees on the first day of the session.

It is obligatory for all the students to appear in all the examinations.

Payment of College Fee

The prescribed fee is to be paid by the student in total at the time of admission. The Registration fee, Migration fee, Examination fee and other fee payable to the university shall have to be paid by the students themselves. The fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances.

Two Year B.Ed. Course
 (Effective from 2015-16 Academic Session)
 (Rules, regulations and syllabus)

1. The structure of the present syllabus is relevant to face to face and regular mode of education only.
2. A Candidate may be allowed to appear in the Bachelor of Education (B. Ed.) Examination provided that after passing B.A/B.Sc./B.Com. or M.A./M.Sc./M. Com. Examination of this University or of any other University, with at least 50% (45% for SC/ST/OBC) marks, recognized for this purpose, he/she has prosecuted for not less than 2 years, a regular course of study in the subjects offered by him/her in a college affiliated to this University for this purpose and has in addition, undergone a course of practical training as indicated below:

Every candidate shall be examined in the following subjects:

3. Rules of Examination results.

- Marks of external & internal examination will not be shown separately.
- A candidate, in order to pass, must obtain at least 40% marks in aggregate i.e. a total of 560 marks out of 1400 marks.
- A candidate will have to secure at least 40% marks in individual paper
- A candidate who secures below 40% in one individual paper but if he/she secures aggregate 40% will be allowed to reappear in the examination as a back paper. (Maximum two back papers will be allowed)
- Candidates securing at least 840 or 60% marks shall be declared to have obtained a First Class.
- Candidates securing marks in between 560 to 839 (both inclusive) shall be declared to have obtained a Second Class.
- A candidate who fails to pass or present himself for the B.Ed. Examination shall not be entitled to claim a refund of the examination fee nor will such fee be carried over for subsequent examination.

- (h) If a student after completion of a regular B.Ed. course and after having obtained his/her admits card does not appear in the B.Ed. Final examination for some unavoidable reason, he/she may appear in the next subsequent examination as a non-collegiate and will be required to pay the prescribed fees.
- (i) If a candidate
 - i. fails in theory part only
 - ii. fails in Practical part only
 - iii. fails to secure pass marks in assignment paper (s)

but otherwise eligible (i.e. 40% out of 1400) to pass the B.Ed. Examination will be given a chance to re-appear or submit the report within two years to clear his/her paper(s)/Practical/report/assignment. But the candidate must take casual admission(s) for the year(s) and pay all the prescribed fees for the subsequent examination(s). If a candidate fails in only one theory paper in the third year from the year of his/her admission he/she shall have a chance to reappear in that paper only in the immediate next year. Results of all such candidates will be declared as per clause 3. (b), 3. (e) & 3. (f).

COURSE STRUCTURE OF TWO YEAR M.Ed. PROGRAMME

(EFFECTIVE FROM SESSION 2016-17)

1. 'This shall be a professional Course of studies leading to the Degree of Master of Education (M.Ed.) and designed only for face to face regular mode of education.
2. Candidates seeking admission to M.Ed. programme should have obtained at least **50% Marks** or an equivalent Grade in the following programme:
 - (i) B. Ed.
 - (ii) B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc.B.Ed.
 - (iii) B. El.Ed.
 - (iv) D.El.Ed. with an Undergraduate Degree (with 50% marks in each)
3. Candidature for admission to M.Ed. Course of an M.A. in Education from Gauhati University or other University shall not be considered as the M.A. in Education course is inclusive of both academic component of Education and also Professional component of M. Ed. Course of G.U.
4. Reservation and relaxation for SC/ST /OBC/PWD and other applicable Categories shall be as per rules of the Central Govt./ State Govt., whichever is applicable.
5. The duration of the course shall be two academic year.
6. The academic session in each academic year will begin in the early part of January and close at the end of December.
7. The course of instruction shall comprise of both compulsory and special Papers of Total 1600 Marks (800 Marks in each academic year)
8. The distribution of papers and course contents in each paper are prescribed in the syllabus.
9. An examination for M.Ed. Degree shall be held on such date and time and place as may be fixed by the University.
10. Each paper of written examination shall carry 75 marks and shall be of three hours duration
11. A candidate may be admitted to the M.Ed. examination provided he/ she has prosecuted a regular

course of studies prescribed for the M.Ed. Course in the University Department/B.Ed. Colleges with M. Ed. Course affiliated to Gauhati University on the following conditions:

- (i) A student must have attended at least 75% of the lectures delivered on each paper and must have attended at least 75% of the full number of classes in each of the subjects prescribed in the syllabus.
 - (ii) Colleges with M. Ed. Course affiliated to Gauhati University shall be required to get the 75% attendance of the students in M. Ed. Classes testified by the University Department compulsorily and procure certificate from Head of the Department of Education, G.U. before allowing the students to appear in the M. Ed. Examination.
 - (iii) Production of certificate from the Head of the Department regarding his/her satisfactory progress of studies and required % of attendance and testifying to his/her good conduct and character shall be required.
 - (iv) No student whose attendance in any Paper is less than 60% shall be allowed to appear in the Examination.
 - (v) A student whose attendance in each paper is at least 60% but less than 75% may be admitted to the examination as a 'Non-Collegiate' candidate on payment of prescribed Non-Collegiate Fee.
 - (vi) Each candidate for M.Ed. Examination shall be required to pay the prescribed Examination fees and other fees as may be prescribed by the University from time to time. A candidate who fails to present himself/herself for the examination shall forfeit his /her fees.
12. In order to obtain the M.Ed. Degree a candidate must obtain at least 40% both in Internal Assessment and External Examination in each paper, but he/she must secure 45% in the aggregate of 16 (Sixteen) Papers.
 13. In order to be placed in the 1st class, a candidate must obtain at least 60% in the aggregate. Candidate securing less than 60% marks in aggregate but securing 45% or above shall be declared to have passed in 2nd Class.
 14. The results of the successful candidates shall be published in order of merit.
 15. If a student after completion of a regular course of study fails to pass or to present himself/ herself in the examination, he/ she may be allowed to appear in two subsequent examination after the completion of the course as a regular candidate.
 16. If a student fails to pass the M.Ed. within three years immediately after completion of the course he/ she shall be required to prosecute a full course of study for any subsequent examination.
 17. Every candidate submitting a Thesis or Dissertation shall be subjected to a Viva-voce examination with a view to testing his acquaintance with the work done in the particular line of research taken up by him/her. Out of 100 marks for Dissertation/Project work, 75 marks are allotted for written assignment/Thesis and 25 marks for Viva-voce Examination.
 18. The Viva-voce examination shall be jointly conducted by two examiners one of which shall be the Guide and Head of the Department of Education as Chairperson of the Board of Examiners.
 19. 25% of the marks allotted to the Thesis/ Dissertation shall be set apart for the Viva- voce examination of the candidate.
